STABILIZING DISCLAIMER

This disclaimer is to inform you, that while we at Knife and Gun Finishing Supplies will give your wood, ivory, horn, and other materials the best care we know how, we cannot guarantee that no distortion or cracking will occur during the stabilizing process.

Should there be any moisture inside your wood cracking or shrinkage may occur either during the process or at a later point in time. Knife and Gun Finishing Supplies will test the outer surface of your wood to ensure its dryness, but will not cut your wood to check the moisture content inside. If we test your materials and they are too wet to stabilize we will dry them but cannot guarantee that no cracking or shrinking will occur. Ensuring the dryness of the wood is the responsibility of the customer.

Ivory and horn take our process very well, but once again it must be dry (not damp, green or fresh and must be oil free). If it is too fresh or damp it may still crack at a later date due to the chemicals not being able to penetrate the material. We have no way to check the moisture content or freshness in ivory and/or horn. It is the responsibility of the consumer to ensure that horn and/or ivory is aged and dry.

Before any material is to be treated, we must ask you to sign this disclaimer stating that you have read and understand that Knife and Gun Finishing will not be responsible for your material if anything should happen during the process.
